15th Annual 2020 Fluke Til Ya Puke Tournament Rules

The Fluke Til Ya Puke fishing tournament is open to all who desire to enter. Saltwater fishing License is required. All participants are required to register and submit the entry fee prior to the start of the tournament. Tournament bracelets will be given to each participating Angler and must be worn throughout the duration of the Captains Meeting, Weigh In and BBQ. The bracelet is your proof of purchase into the tournament, as well as your food and drink ticket. No Bracelet, no weigh in, no food or drinks. (The Captains Meeting is Optional. If you do not plan on attending the Captains meeting, please make yourself aware of the tournament rules. Captains bags with t-shirts can be picked up the day of the tournament).

Fish at your own risk.

Adult entry fee is \$ 55 per angler.

Jr. Angler Division – 12 and under \$45 per Angler.

The fee is nontransferable and nonrefundable.

The eligible species is fluke (summer flounder) the minimum size to weigh in is 19 inches.

All fish remain property of angler.

In the event of a tie the earliest registered fish wins.

Captains meeting, sign ups, and beer bust 6:00pm – 9:00pm June 19th, 2020 at Point View Marina, 11 Sherman Road S. Kingstown RI.

Time limits- lines in at 5:00 am Saturday June 20th, 2020 and concludes with all lines out of the water at 1:00 pm Saturday June 20th, 2020.

All fish must be weighed in and registered at Point View Marina, 11 Sherman Road S. Kingstown RI. - Fluke Til Ya Puke headquarters from 1:00pm-4:00pm Saturday June 20th, 2020.

Awards ceremony, cookout with live band to follow.

The scales close at 4:00pm Saturday June 20th, 2020!

We will weigh fish after 4:00pm only if you have checked in with the weigh master by the 4:00pm dead line

Fish must be caught by rod and reel only by the angler who has paid and registered in the tournament.

Only one fish can be weighed in per angler

Jr. Angler Division – 12 and under.

All winners in each division or Calcutta will be subject to a Polygraph (Lie Detector) Test. No Exceptions!

All fish must comply with Rhode Island State fishing regulations. Any cheating in anyway will not be tolerated. If your fish looks like it was caught by any means other than rod and reel, or if it is undersized you will be disqualified. No exceptions!

All protests must be submitted verbally and in writing immediately after the tournament Director closes the scales. The

Tournament Director will hear any and all protests. The Tournament Director has the right to give a polygraph test to anyone in question. The decisions of the Tournament Director are final.

There are no geographical fishing boundaries.

-\$500 Costa Del Mar Grand High Stakes Calcutta

\$500 entry fee per team / boat. Biggest Fluke entered in the \$500 Costa Del Mar Calcutta wins the pot, as well as Costa sunglasses and Costa swag.

-\$100.00 High stakes Calcutta

Entry Fee \$100 per boat

50% of the Calcutta goes to the biggest Fluke entered in the Calcutta, 30% of the Calcutta goes to the 2nd biggest Fluke entered in the Calcutta, and 20% of the Calcutta goes to the 3rd biggest Fluke entered in the Calcutta.

-Big 3 Calcutta

Entry fee \$20 per boat

Biggest 3 fluke wins the Calcutta (the grand prize fish can't be entered in the big 3)

-Trash fish Calcutta

Entry fee \$10 per angler

Biggest skate, dog fish, Atlantic torpedo, and any other non-sport fish wins Calcutta.

-Biggest Sea Bass Calcutta (If Sea Bass Season Is Open) – Awarded to the angler who weighs in the largest Sea Bass.

Entry fee \$10.00 per angler. If Sea bass season is Closed, This will become the largest Bluefish Calcutta.

All anglers will receive a tournament t-shirt at a first come first serve basis we have 1500 shirts available when they are gone they are gone. Entry fee is not nonrefundable.
